Ordinance 19-02

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance 16-07 Concerning The South Point Utilities Water System And Declaring An Emergency

Whereas, the Council of the Village of South Point, Ohio has deemed it necessary to amend ordinance 16-07 to improve and maintain the water system.

Whereas, the health and safety of the residents of said Village and the users on said system may be directly affected.

Now Therefore Be It Ordained, by the Council of the Village of South Point, Ohio that Section 2 and Section 4 of the South Point Utilities water rate ordinance is hereby amended and any legislation in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The new rates shall be effective as of Mar. 6, 2019.

Section 4. Should the bill for any services rendered by South Point Utilities waterworks system remain unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days, such water services may be cut off and such services shall be resumed only upon full payment of the bill plus an additional \$75.00 reconnect fee.

If a property owner requests his water service turned off during normal SPU working hours of 8:00AM to 4:00PM Monday thru Friday, the turn off fee shall be \$50.00. If the request for turn off service is after SPU working hours, weekends or holidays, the fee shall be \$75.00. No additional fee to turn the water back on.

If a bill remains unpaid for a period of ninety (90) days, it may be certified to the County Auditor at the earliest time allowed and collected at the same time and manner as all other property taxes as provided by Ohio Revised Code 743.04

Section 5. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure to provide adequate operating revenues to continue to furnish proper water service to the residents and the users on said water system and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
